## AN ACT

Amending the act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284), entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising, and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of 3 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and 4 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds 5 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and 6 7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and supervision of insurance carried by such companies, 8 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by 9 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and 10 repealing existing laws," in comprehensive health care for 11 12 uninsured children, further providing for CHILDREN'S HEALTH CARE AND FOR expiration. 13 14 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 Section 1. - 5 (G) LIMITATION OF COVERAGE. -- THE BENEFIT PACKAGE FOR
- 6 ELIGIBLE CHILDREN MAY NOT INCLUDE REIMBURSEMENT FOR GENDER OR
- 7 SEX REASSIGNMENT SURGERY OR GENDER OR SEX TRANSITION SERVICES,
- 8 INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO, PHYSICIAN'S SERVICES, INPATIENT
- 9 <u>AND OUTPATIENT HOSPITAL SERVICES, PRESCRIBED DRUGS OR COUNSELING</u>
- 10 SERVICES RELATED TO SUCH SURGERY OR SERVICES.
- 11 SECTION 2. SECTION 2309-A OF THE ACT, ADDED DECEMBER 20,
- 12 2015 (P.L.461, NO.84), IS AMENDED TO READ:
- 13 Section 2309-A. Expiration.
- 14 (a) General rule. -- [This] Subject to subsection (a.1), this
- 15 article shall expire on the earlier of:
- 16 (1) December 31, [2017] <u>2019</u>; or
- 17 (2) ninety days after the date on which Federal funding
- 18 for the program ceases to be available.
- 19 (a.1) Exception. -- If Federal law authorizes funding for the
- 20 program for a period that extends beyond December 31, 2019, this
- 21 <u>article shall expire under subsection (a)(2).</u>
- 22 (b) Notice. -- If [the chapter] this article expires under
- 23 subsection (a)(2), as determined by the department, the
- 24 department shall transmit notice to the Legislative Reference
- 25 Bureau for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin.
- Section  $\frac{2}{3}$ . This act shall take effect immediately.
